Radim Beránek studied chemistry at the University of Chemistry and Technology in Prague, Czech Republic. He finished his PhD under the supervision of Prof. Horst Kisch at the Friedrich-Alexander University Erlangen-Nürnberg in 2007. He is currently associate professor in the Institute of Electrochemistry at Ulm University, Germany. Before moving to Ulm he has been junior professor at the Ruhr University Bochum, Germany (2010 – 2015). His research interests combine aspects of synthetic chemistry with aspects of physico-chemical (*e.g.*, photoelectrochemical and spectroscopic) characterization and utilization of novel hybrid and composite materials as building blocks for functional architectures and devices for solar energy conversion and environmental applications.
