Prof. Sivula studied at the University of Minnesota, obtaining a Bachelor degree in Chemical Engineering in 2002, and at the University of California, Berkeley, completing a doctorate in 2007 under the direction of Prof. Jean Fréchet. He then joined Prof. Michael Grätzel's group at EPFL as a postdoc, and in 2011 he began an independent research program as Assistant Professor in the Institute of Chemical Sciences and Engineering at EPFL, where he was promoted to Associate Professor of Chemical Engineering in 2018. His research group, the Laboratory for molecular engineering of optoelectronic nanomaterials (LIMNO), is directed towards advancing solution-processed semiconductors for solar energy conversion, especially the production of solar fuels.
